## NOTES FROM COMMANDER HAL DULLE

The Missouri Legislature is back in session which means the Missouri Association of Veterans Organizations

(MAVO), of which the American Legion is a member, will conduct a rally January 23, 2024 at 8:00AM in the Capitol Rotunda, to support the MAVO Legislative Agenda. While you may or may not attend, it is important that you let your legislators know that you are supporting the veteran's agenda. Your voice is important for legislators are very sensitive to how their constituents feel about issues.

MAVO has four items on our 2024 legislative agenda. The top priority is to "Fully fund the Missouri Veterans Commission (MVC) and transfer its personnel services to funding by General Revenue".

The next agenda item is to "advocate for additional funding to increase Veteran's Service Officers and their pay to include Grant Partnership Veterans Organizations Service Officers to help ensure Missouri's veterans receive benefits they have earned through their service".

And, on the agenda is to "Enhance Real and Personal Property Tax exemptions for 100% disabled veterans.

And finally, "Allocate the first 10% of internet gaming revenue to the Missouri Veterans Commission.

These pro-veteran initiatives are critical in providing the necessary tools needed to administer services that you veterans have earned. These are not handouts but rather part of the promises our government made to you for your service and sacrifice. Please take a moment and get involved. We have political clout and we should use it.
