I encourage our older veterans to consider our Veterans Homes, if just to get information about what it will take to get admission to a Home. I hear sadly, there are occasions when one of our veterans have a stroke or heart attack or just a fall somewhere and the doctor will tell the spouse that the veteran will need long term care following a short period of rehabilitation. Trying to find a reasonable, highly efficient long-term facility can be a tremendous challenge during this time. Take the time to check out facilities that meet your needs now.

Next post meeting on April 16th will be our standard meeting. Please come out, meet other members and participate.

Finally, help track veteran's issues at the state capital and help us improve benefits and opportunities for our veterans. They certainly deserve them.
