Ride safe over the extended Fourth of July week!

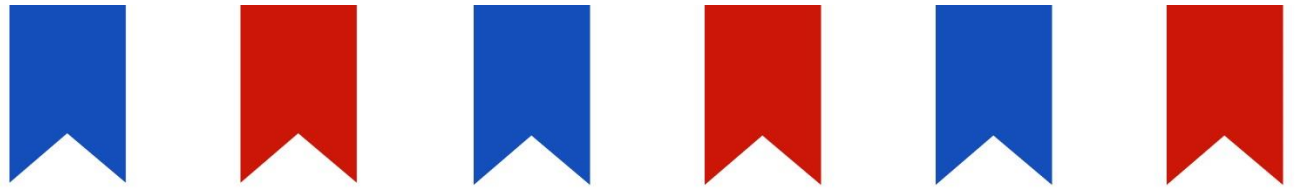
All rides are posted on our website. Always check there for updates. Be safe in the heat!
